The folder in which each item is located is identified by underlined text. Files are mainly PDF or RTF formats, with one or two in Microsoft Word for technical reasons.

As of Cycle 15, some files on the course CD may require Adobe Reader 7.0 or later, or equivalent PDF reader software. As we locate these, we are converting them to be compatible with Adobe Reader 3.0 or later to accommodate students with older computers that may be incompatible with newer software. We can also send downward compatible files during the course if we miss any. We strongly recommend that you download the latest version of Adobe Reader (free), or equivalent, that runs on your computer.

**We recommend that you register before or at the same time that you order your books.** *You cannot receive the lower student rate for the reading package if you have not registered.*

NOTE: Because of exorbitant bank fees to exchange non-U.S. Currency into US dollars, WE CAN ONLY ACCEPT PAYMENT BY CHECK DRAWN ON A US BANK OR BY INTERNATIONAL POSTAL MONEY ORDER IN US DOLLARS. IMPORTANT. Make checks payable to Yankee Permaculture. **However make postal money orders payable exactly as follows: "Dan or Cynthia Hemenway."** (Not "Dan Hemenway" or "Cynthia Hemenway" but "Dan or Cynthia Hemenway"—all four words!) Incorrectly assigned postal money orders may cause delay of shipment. The US post office may refuse to cash postal money orders made to Yankee Permaculture!

**PayPal.** Yankee Permaculture no longer accepts payment via PayPal.

**EXPEDITED SHIPMENT** requires payment by bank check or money order. See instructions below. Personal or business checks are fine, but shipment will take place no sooner than two weeks after receipt of your check. **Use of any delivery service except US Post Office will delay your order. We don't want delivery vehicles coming to our home! Sending payment by a means that requires our signature can substantially delay your order.** We strongly recommend against mailing cash.

**Prices subject to change.** **There can be no substitutions if ordering from this list.** Offers subject to availability of texts from publishers. If you feel obliged to ask for substitutions or deletions anyway, please take your permaculture training from someone else! If you have a lot of these publications, you can fill in at retail prices using the Yankee Permaculture Order Form. Again, you must register to get the lower student rate.

## About the Course CD

The course CD includes almost all the "standard instructors' posts" from the Online Course, numerous reading resources and many other references. Most contents of the *Permaculture Design Course CD* are listed earlier in this document. **The tuition for monitors is waived with registrations received at the same time (in the same envelope) that we receive their order for the full CD or Reading Package. Students and monitors receive the CD when they purchase the full reading package. If you get the reading package, you do not need to order the CD separately.** We strongly recommend that you compute the total costs before ordering materials retail, because even with some duplications the reading package usually costs less. **We will not compute these matters for you. In all cases, you must do your own arithmetic.** The ability to perform simple addition is a requirement for enrollment. Permaculture is a self-reliance movement, among other characteristics.

## MOVING ITEMS FROM THE HARD COPY LIST TO THE CD LIST

We are presently in the last stages of a program to convert a number of hard-copy documents to digital format. As we do this, we will add these to the CD list and remove them from the hard copy list. **This will be done without notice.**

As in all permaculture design decisions, we have several reasons for converting as much as possible to CD:

- 1) We save paper and therefore trees.
- 2) We save money and energy in printing and in shipping.
- 3) Savings enable us to reduce price increases for total reading package due to increases in the prices

charged by publishers of the books that we use. We are often able to add resource materials to the CD at no increase in price. The CD price has been stable for many years; only the price of the printed materials has risen.

## Future Developments

The course CD, over time, becomes richer in images and large files of various kinds.

Besides enriching the course CD, we are developing other kinds of permaculture CDs. Our substantial series of permaculture slide-shows are being converted to digital format for individual use. Inquire about availability of specific presentations. And we are considering CDs consisting of permaculture designs, and of standard designs." Some of these projects will depend on the demand for this course CD. If you are particularly interested in such materials, please

let us know. Of course you can get many of these materials in other formats already, from our regular offering of papers and our list of slide-script shows available for sale.

The publications on this reading list apply to broad aspects of permaculture. Information pertaining specific circumstances is listed in many other publications on our regular order form.

**People who do not require certification** and who wish to study permaculture independently can use the *Permaculture Design Course CD* and the course reading list to conduct their own course of study. We recommend that you use the course assignment schedule in the **Course Tools** folder of the CD to structure your reading and other work. Be sure to follow the readings in the **Weekly Posts** folder. By using the contents folder provided with each weekly module, you can skip reading administrative posts that are mainly for registered students and go straight to the lectures, notes and outlines for each module.

Course monitors can also “listen in” to the class discussion and get some supplemental email posts of material not covered by the reading list. **Anyone who licenses the course self-study CD may also monitor the course discussions, student reports, and other online activities.** The **required** registration form is available on our web site. In order to get the CD and monitor the course for one price, you must register to monitor the earliest course cycle scheduled after you have purchased your CD. **You must register at the time that you license your CD.** If you plan to get the reading list, you can save money by registering and buying the reading list at the same time. Monitors must also post an introduction at the outset of the course cycle or as soon as they join the course.

For the most complete information about the online course, download the **course preregistration package** from our web site. This contains the course protocol, reading assignments, reading package data, registration, and scholarship information.

To begin practice permaculture design, even at home, it is advisable to get some training or guidance from an established permaculture designer.

## FLORIDA PROGRAMS

Therefore, we are available to lead permaculture programs around the North Central Florida region, particularly programs that take place over series of weekends. NOTE: We rely on hosts to provide all promotion and organization of our programs. We supply teaching. That's enough. ☺ If you want to organize a training program, we recommend that you work in conjunction with a group or college with experience in putting these on. Usually hosts organize programs at least partly because we use their

homes as the design training site. We have provided rather complete information about the types of training programs that we have designed and the requirements of hosts on our website.
